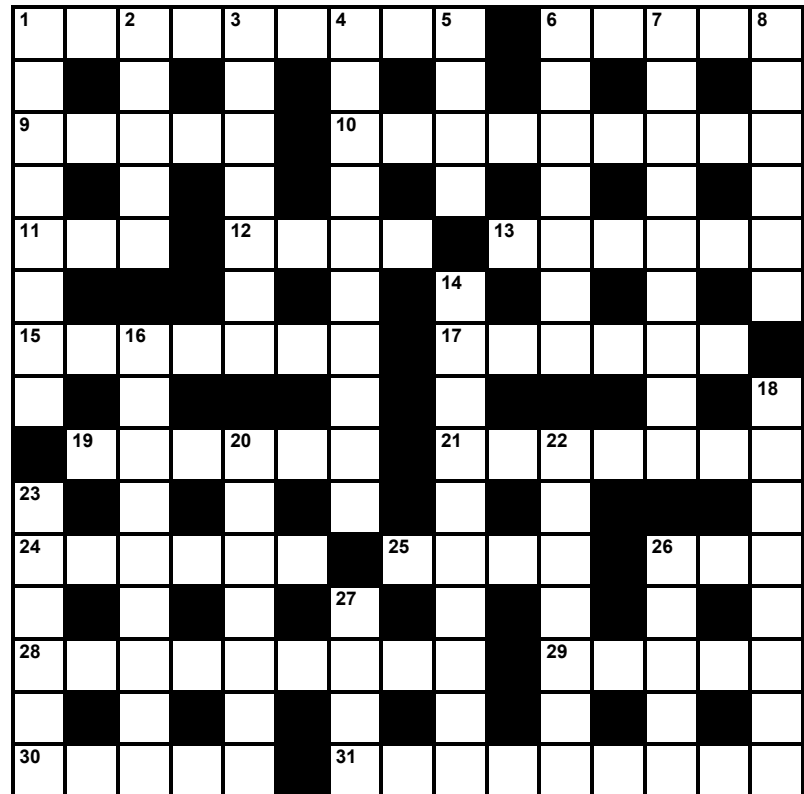


Hemical 68 *by Hemical*
